PLANNING COMMISSION MINUTES

OCTOBER 22, 2014

CALL TO ORDER: Chair Robert Allen called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Commissioners Jan Ostlund, Tom Howard, Per Odegaard, Pat Tallon, John Zevenbergen, and Jennifer Ange were present. Town Planner Bill Trimm and Clerk-Treasurer Joyce Bielefeld were also present.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: *September 17, 2014*

Commissioner Tallon moved to approve the minutes of September 17, 2014. *Commissioner Ostlund* seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

DISCUSSION: DRAFT OF CHAPTER 7 – PARKS AND RECREATION ELEMENT – BILL TRIMM

Town Planner Bill Trimm shared that the Parks and Recreation Element is an optional element of the Comprehensive Plan. He reviewed the proposed changes to the element; the majority of the changes related to the new Deer Creek Park property and the improvements to the Woodway Reserve that have already been implemented. The Commissioners discussed the proposed changes and suggested that a policy be added addressing pedestrian access from Richmond Beach to Marine Park in Edmonds. The access way should be along the east side of the railroad tracks. Planner Trimm said that he would include the access way in the parks element.

ACTION: *Commissioner Ostlund* moved to approve the draft of the Parks and Recreation Element with the additional language regarding Richmond Beach Access. *Commissioner Odegaard* seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

OTHER BUSINESS: Mr. Trimm gave an update on the Snohomish County population targets and the Point Wells EIS process.
